Priest: We praise you that before he suffered and died, our Saviour gave us this holy meal to share and told us to continue it until he comes again

**Young People: Why do we eat bread together at this table?**

Priest: On the night before he died, Jesus took bread. After giving thanks, he broke it, and gave it to his disciples saying, "Take, eat. This is my body, given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

**Young People: Why do we drink from the cup together at this table?**

Priest: In the same way after supper Jesus took the cup, saying, "This cup is God's new covenant sealed with my blood, poured out for you for the forgiveness of sins. Do this in remembrance of me."

**Young People: What do we remember at this table?**

Priest: We remember the Father's gracious love for us, Christ's death and resurrection for us, and the Spirit's tender care for us

Lay Minister: Let us proclaim the mystery of faith:

**All (Said): Christ has died  
Christ is risen  
Christ will come again.**

Priest: Merciful Father, pour out your Holy Spirit on us and on these gifts of bread and wine. In eating and drinking together may we be made one with Christ and with one another.

**All: Amen**
