
3 What Does the Bible Say?

- ➤ ongoing




Community/Trinity

* Jesus

- > at the centre
- ➤ God has empowered Him
- ➤ Jesus' authority
- ➤ not just an opinion
- ➤ the disciples came to Jesus
- ➤ we need to come to Him
- ➤ there is real power
- ➤ Jesus' promise to be with them always
- > we don't live on our own
- ➤ not done in our own strength
- ➤ God never leaves us
- ➤ we are accompanied by Jesus
- ➤ even if we don't "feel" Him near

2) Romans 6: 3-11 Notes * "Death" & "Resurrection" ➤ dying to former way of life ➤ no longer trapped by sin ➤ no longer self-centred ➤ no longer live for self ➤ sharing in Jesus' resurrection ➤ power to live a new life ➤ with Jesus' obedience * New relationship ➤ new relationship with Jesus ➤ only God can bring it about living in a new reality with God * New community > one by one ➤ shared experience > creates a new humanity ➤ the "Body of Christ" ➤ "in Christ" renewed in the Eucharist ➤ joining with community of faith ➤ we rise to new life with Jesus

➤ a resurrection community

"Dead to sin/Alive to God Notes in Jesus" ➤ life which shows faith ➤ obedience to God ➤ noticed by others (compare this with Romans 1:5; John 3: 36; Romans 16:19; 2 Corinthians 9: 13: 1 Peter 1: 2: and all of Romans chapters 6 and 7) God achieved through Jesus ➤ obedient life ➤ initiative lies with Jesus results of completed work ⇒ people back to God **⇒** rescues the world ⇒ restores the world ⇒ sin's hold broken **⇒** free to <u>choose</u> to serve Jesus 3).Iohn 3: 1-8 * Holy Spirit ➤ initiative not ours ➤ baby's role is passive ➤ doesn't take charge * New Life ➤ not ours to bring about "being born again" ➤ the power lies with God ➤ Nicodemus sees us in charge ➤ the whole process is God's

* New Birth Notes ➤ Parents' ongoing responsibilities physical / material \Leftrightarrow spiritual ⇔ do not baptise children back into the world Godparents' ongoing responsibilities ⇔ sponsors *⇔* guarantors ⇔ intercessors > much care and guidance without this it is devalued and wasted * Parents/Godparents > role of parents and godparents is key ➤ attention and guidance over many years ➤ if these are missing, it is better to delay ➤ instruction & demonstration ➤ faith is more *caught* than taught

Jesus accepted Nicodemus **Notes** ➤ not playing games with God ➤ Jesus starts where we are ➤ we relate to a God who is in charae God is beyond comprehension ➤ we trust God as we follow "Jesus tells Nicodemus the reason behind this all in God really loves the world so much John 3:16. that God initiated this rescue operation! God's clear intention is that all people should accept this free offer and live! But the choice to do so or not, is our choice. God has given us freedom to choose and will not force even good things onto us if we don't want them. Allowing Jesus to die for our guilt was an enormous cost to God – when we follow Jesus faithfully in our lives, we may find that it will cost us as well - not surprisingly! We will all one day have to give account for how we have used the many gifts and abilities that God has given us, including the power to choose. The ultimate goal of Baptism for the parents and godparents is to see their child take on these responsibilities personally in Confirmation (a signing on for full adult responsibility in God's church)."
